Terms and conditions

- Entries are limited to UK residents aged under 35 years on Tuesday 30th July 2024.
- Only entries submitted via the NSA website between Monday 20th May and Tuesday 18th June 2024 will be accepted.
- Information provided via the competition entry form will be stored by both NSA and Kepak – see below.
- Shortlisting will be conducted by a judging panel of NSA and Kepak representatives and take place from Tuesday 18th June and Friday 5th July 2024.
- All individuals who enter the competition with a valid entry (i.e. a full response given to all questions on the application form) will be contacted in the week beginning Monday 8th July to inform them if they have or have not reached the shortlist. Regardless of whether they've made the shortlist or not, all individuals who are not NSA members will be offered a free ticket for the NSA Sheep Event on Tuesday 30th July 2024. Individual who are NSA members can gain free entry by showing a valid membership card at the gate.
- For the three individuals who reach the shortlist, information provided in their application form and other information relevant to the competition provided to NSA and/or Kepak will be used by NSA and Kepak in press and publicity.
- Shortlisted competitors are required to participate in press and publicity before and after the NSA Sheep Event. They are required to attend the NSA Sheep Event on Tuesday 30th July 2024, answer questions posed by the judging panel in a public forum on the NSA stand, and have photographs taken. Failure to participate in any of these will result in their position on the shortlist being withdrawn (and potentially offered to someone else) and forfeiture of any prize money.
- The judges' decision will be made on Tuesday 30th July 2024 and will be final; neither NSA or Kepak will enter into dialogue about their decision.
- Prizes are a) £400, a certificate and a cut glass paperweight for the winner and b) £150 and a certificate for each of the two runners up. No alternatives will be given. Money will be paid by NSA via cash transfer after NSA Sheep 2024.
- Shortlisted competitors will be invited to the NSA Sheep Industry Dinner on the evening of Monday 29th July 2024, as a guest of Kepak. Overnight accommodation will not be provided.

Data collection. Information collected via the competition entry form (including personal data) will be stored securely by NSA and used in accordance with the [NSA Privacy Policy](#). This includes competitors being added to the NSA Wider Interest Group, if they are not already an NSA member. All information will be shared with Kepak and stored/used in accordance with the [Kepak Privacy Policy](#). It will not be shared with any other party outside NSA and Kepak.
