



Information for sellers

- Rams to be penned by 12 noon for inspection and judging in the pens. The market opens at 7am. All penning is under cover
 and free of charge. The market prefers rams to be penned on sawdust. Vendors must supply their own forage.
- Vendors are advised not to unload any sheep at the sale before obtaining clear instructions from the sale stewards. Kindly
 observe instructions from stewards and follow direction signs as appropriate.
- Stock movement forms and any relevant licenses must accompany all sheep.
- Vendors of sheep are asked to comply strictly with the rules as set out by the SRUC Maedi Visna Scheme. All sheep must be
 accompanied by official certificates of MV status.
- Rams must be identified by means of a clearly marked paint brand lot number. The market will not provide lot numbers.
- It is the responsibility of vendors to take their rams, in catalogue order, to the collecting pen in good time prior to entry to the sale ring.
- · Vendors must make sure their rams have sold before leaving the market.
- For vendors wishing to enter into the pre-sale show, judging will be in the pens no earlier than 12 noon. Classes are for
 groups of four rams.

Pre sale inspection and general information

- All rams will be sold subject to an inspection by NSA. Inspection is a condition of entry to the sale but compliance with this
 inspection shall in no way form a guarantee to the purchaser of the animals so inspected. All rejected sheep must be removed
 from the sale pens. They cannot pass through the sale ring. Rejected sheep showing lesions suggestive of caseous
 lymphadenitis (CLA) must be removed from the sale pens immediately.
- Though care is taken to inspect every ram for defects, the final onus remains with the purchaser.
- The inspectors will consider the following for each ram: identification is as required by legislation; not suffering from any infectious or contagious disease; two adequately sized testicles of approximately the same size and normal consistency; of a quality commensurate with the level set by the NSA Eastern Region Committee, of adequate weight for the age, and showing no abnormal formation in structure; teeth are in the correct position; and no deviation in the structure of feet and/or legs.
- All sheep must comply with any Defra regulations in force at the time of sale.
- All rams entered into the sale are MV-accredited. Care must be taken by vendors and purchasers not to infringe MV rules and
 regulations. While every care will be taken by the NSA Eastern Region Committee and the auctioneers, neither can take
 responsibility for any infringements, carelessness or consequences arising therefrom.

Sale information

- Selling with commence at 2.30pm approximately (at the conclusion of the breeding ewe sale).
- All rams are sold subject to the Livestock Auctioneers Association (LAA) conditions of sale and the NSA Eastern Region Rugby Ram Sale bylaws.
- The minimum bid is 300gns, unless the vendor has provided written reserves to the auctioneer to set a higher minimum price for an individual ram.
- No rams shall be sold on the premises by private treaty other than those which have been offered for sale in the ring first. All
 rams sold by private treaty after leaving the ring must not be below the minimum set price (300gns) and must be booked
 through the auctioneer and the appropriate commission paid.
- Complaints must be notified to the auctioneers within one hour of the end of the sale or before removal from the market, whichever is the sooner. The purchaser shall have no rights to claim damages from the vendor in respect of indirect or consequential loss such as (but limited to) loss of profit or any other loss whatsoever.
- An Auctioneers Slip shall be handed to the purchaser upon completion and also pass out slips for sheep not sold. These must
 be retained carefully for inspection by stewards until final departure from the ground. All stock, sold and unsold, must be
 cleared by 6.30pm.
- NSA accepts no responsibility whatsoever for loss, injury or damage to any persons or their property.


