Travelling from the South

Take the A90 north signposted Aberdeen. Pass Perth, Dundee, Forfar and Brechin. Pass Stracathro Service Station and about a mile further on leave the A90 at Northwaterbridge. Turn L off the A90 and then immediately R signed Fettercairn. Follow the unclassified road to Fettercairn where you pick up the B974 signed Banchory. Follow this for about 3 ½ miles to the Clatterin Brig Tea Room where you turn R on the unclassified road signed Drumtochty and Auchenblae. Glensaugh is reached after about ½ mile. Turn R into the farm, pass some farm buildings to your L and R. The office and reception then lies to your L in about 100m.

Travelling from the North (Aberdeen)

Take the A90 south signposted Edinburgh. Pass Stonehaven and about 10 miles further south turn R off A90 into the village of Fordoun. Head north on the old road for about 200m then take a L turn to cross over the railway. Follow this road to the village of Auchenblae. When you reach Auchenblae turn R up the main street. At the top turn L signed Drumtochty, Glensaugh. Pass Drumtochty Castle and after another 2 miles pass Loch Saugh on your L. Glensaugh is about ½ mile further on your L.

When you reach Glensaugh

Turn into the main farm entrance when you see the big Glensaugh sign. Pass farm building L and R and keep going straight on for about 50m. The farm office will be visible to your L. Visitors are always met at the office. Please remember that Glensaugh is a working farm and visitors should not wander around unaccompanied. A signing in book and risk assessment for visitors is available at reception. Parking is at the rear of the office.
