- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify NSA.

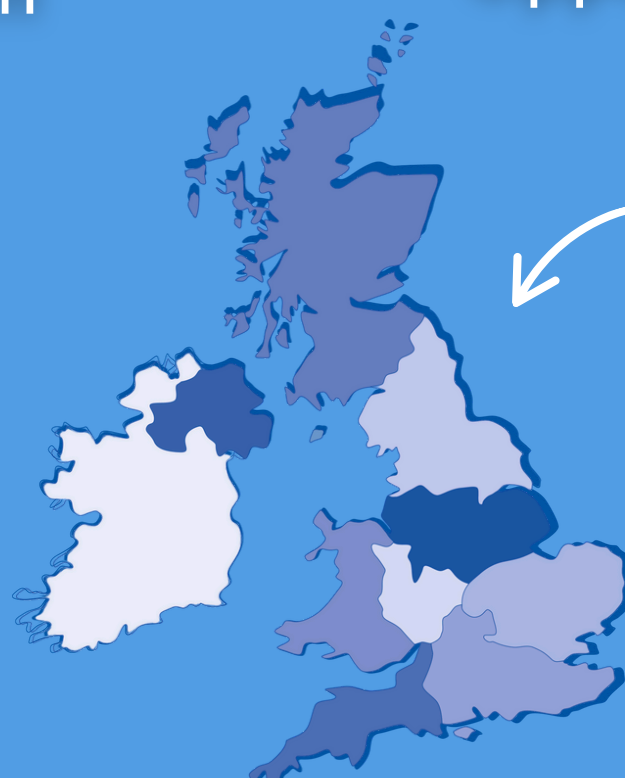
