Guidance notes for NSA members using the Graziers List

During the application process

- Once NSA has verified the information you have provided, it will be published on the NSA Graziers List on the NSA website at www.nationalsheep.org.uk/graziers-list. This is an open-access page that all can view.
- Please note, adverts can be submitted anytime but are manually published on the NSA website and can only be added Tuesday-Thursday (9am-5.00pm).
- All agreements are done so between the two farming parties; NSA is only responsible for registering and publishing your details, so it is up to you to decide if a grazing opportunity / sheep flock is suitable.
- Once you have made a suitable connection, **please notify NSA and your advert will be taken down so no one else contacts you.**

Looking ahead

- The NSA Graziers List is a new service and so to make sure NSA is providing you with the best possible service, please email any thoughts or feedback to enquiries@nationalsheep.org.uk.
- NSA's aim is to provide the connection but it is up to the farmers or graziers to progress the relationship to see if it will work.
- NSA takes no responsibility for any failed agreements but is interested to know why relationships have or haven't worked, with the aim of improving the service.
